Agreement:

I agree to properly maintain the trees planted in the public Right-of-Way (ROW), common area, or drainage easement in proximity to the above property for as long as I live at this address, with the understanding that future owners and residents are also required to maintain landscaping planted in these areas per locally applicable ordinances.

~ Maintenance includes:

- o Watering and pruning to ensure the tree(s) do not cause any traffic-visibility hazards,
- o Assuring that pedestrians have clear access to any walking path/sidewalk areas (the City of Tucson requires a minimum 5'-wide walking path to be maintained in the right-of-way, and that trees be pruned to maintain a clear pedestrian-pathway area 5 feet wide and 7 feet high), and,
- o Where applicable, that stormwater flow will not be impeded.

~ Plant trees AT LEAST 10 feet from sewer lines, 5 feet from water lines, and 3 feet from other utility lines.

Do not plant under overhead lines. Do not plant in public Right-of-Way (ROW) without both a permit & Blue Stake clearance (dial 811 or (800) 782-5348).

~ Planting and maintenance instructions are provided with trees.

I agree to hold Trees for Tucson, the Dunbar/Spring Neighborhood Association, and all volunteer tree planters and organizers harmless for all liability associated with the trees or tree planting and maintenance.
